Today is the big day!

It's **July 31, 2006**, and Campus Solutions—comprising **Campus Community** and **Recruiting & Admissions**—is now live in the University of Maine System. Some reminders about this implementation:

- It is no longer possible to **UPDATE** bio-demographic data (names, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, ethnicity, etc.) in ISIS and WebDSIS.
- It is still possible to **VIEW** bio-demo data in ISIS and WebDSIS.
- Faculty and staff will use the **Campus Community** module to enter, update or view student bio-demographic data (names, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, ethnicity, etc.). Enter through the **MaineStreet portal**.
- Current students and applicants will use Student Self-Service to enter and update bio-demo data.
- There are links in WebDSIS directly to the **MaineStreet portal**.
- A nightly process will update ISIS and WebDSIS with any bio-demo data changes made in Campus Community during the business day.
- Admission applications for Fall '06 and Spring '07 will still be entered into ISIS.
- Admissions offices and the Shared Processing Center will use the **Recruiting and Admissions** module for applications for Summer '07 and beyond. Other offices will use this module to view the status of applications.
- Applicants for admission to a UMS campus will use Student Self-Service to track the progress of an application.
- Links on the MaineStreet portal will take current students, applicants, and employees to information about activating their UMS ID and password accounts.
- Check the online training tools and documentation if you attended training but have forgotten how to navigate in the new system. Choose "**Training Tools and Materials**" in your menu bar, or go to http://www.maine.edu/system/pe/project_enterprise.php for links to Quick Guides, Business Processes, iDemos, and A Project Glossary.
- If you log into the MaineStreet portal and do not see the menu pick for **Campus Solutions** but think you should, or if you have other questions or problems, contact the appropriate person or number at your university, listed in the **July 17 Employee Update** (<http://www.maine.edu/pdf/July06special1.pdf>).
