**SUBJECT** WEAPONS POLICY

**Revised:** 1/10/97

The following policy governing dangerous weapons on campus applies to all students, employees, and visitors.

Dangerous weapons, including, but not limited to firearms, bows, arrows, rockets, sling-shots, air-guns, knives, edged weapons, and martial arts weapons, are not permitted on property owned by or under the control of the University of Maine at Farmington and at off-campus activities sponsored by the University of Maine at Farmington.

Any exception must be approved by the Director of the Department of Public Safety and shall be subject to such terms and conditions as the Director shall deem reasonable. Police Officers are exempt.

Any member of the University community who violates this policy shall be subject to appropriate disciplinary action up to and including dismissal from the University.

Any person who is not a member of the University community who violates this policy shall be notified at once orally or in writing as soon as possible after the discovery. If the violation does not cease forthwith, or if the person does not leave the University premises forthwith, the person shall be subject to all appropriate procedures and penalties including, but not limited to the application of the criminal trespass provisions of the law of the State of Maine or the enforcement of the dangerous weapons laws of the State of Maine.
