INTRODUCTION

This report provides summary information regarding University enrollments. The tables and graphs show enrollments for the past 11 years, i.e., 1995-2005.

HIGHLIGHTS

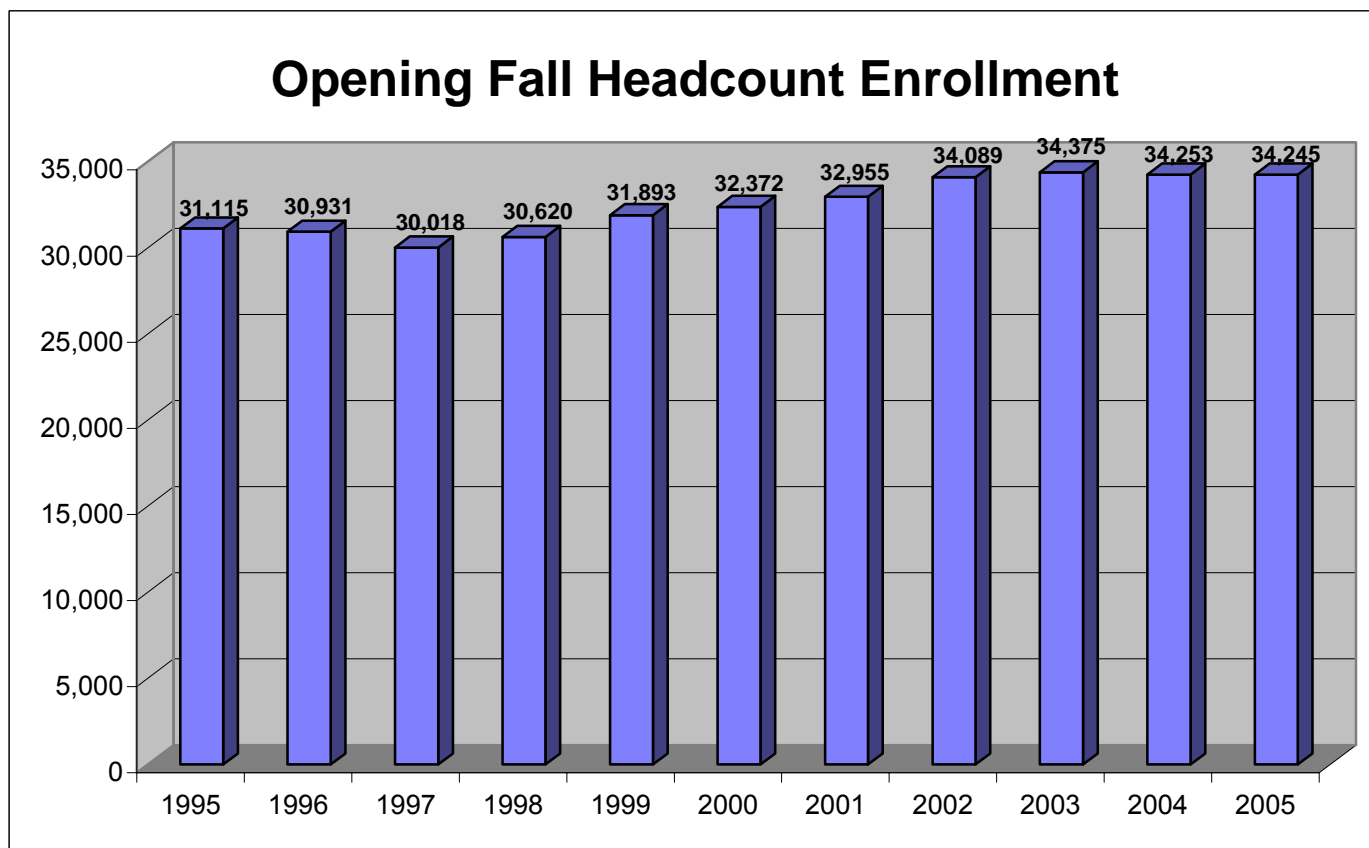
- **For the fourth year in a row, enrollment within the University of Maine System exceeds 34,000 students, with those students enrolled in more classes than at any other time in the university system's 37-year history.**
- **Compared to last fall, the number of full-time students is up by 63 and the number of part-time students is down by 71, a total decrease in headcount enrollment of 8 students, resulting in 34,245 students attending the University of Maine System. There are 129 more FTE students (0.5%) compared to last fall.**
- **Students who are Maine residents number 29,983 which is 87.6% of total enrollment. In-state enrollment decreased by 8 students and out-of-state enrollment did not change from the previous fall. International students (1,172) increased by 6 students and represent 3.4% of the student body.**
- **Of the 34,245 students, there are 21,308 women who make up 62.2% of the student body and 12,937 men, which account for the other 37.8%.**
- **Every county in Maine sends at least 350 students to the University of Maine System. The largest numbers come from Cumberland (5,995), Penobscot (4,739), Kennebec (3,297), and York (3,009).**
- **Students come from all but two states in the country, plus the District of Columbia. A total of 57.6% of out-of-state students (excluding international students) come from the other New England states. Massachusetts alone accounts for 23% of students coming from other states.**
- **The University of Maine System has students from 78 different countries enrolled. The largest delegation comes from Canada (818 or 69.8%).**

HIGHLIGHTS CONTINUED

- **There are a total of 3,407 students enrolled in distance learning courses in Fall 2005, down 2.8% from 3,504 students in Fall 2004. Distance learning credits are 14,434 compared to 14,808 in Fall 2004 (a decrease of 2.5%.) About 72%, or 2, 437 students, are only enrolled in distance learning courses.**

A summary profile of distance learning students is as follows:

- **83% are part-time**
- **70% are associate or non-degree**
- **80% are women**
- **80% are 23 years of age or older (53% are 31 years of age or older)**



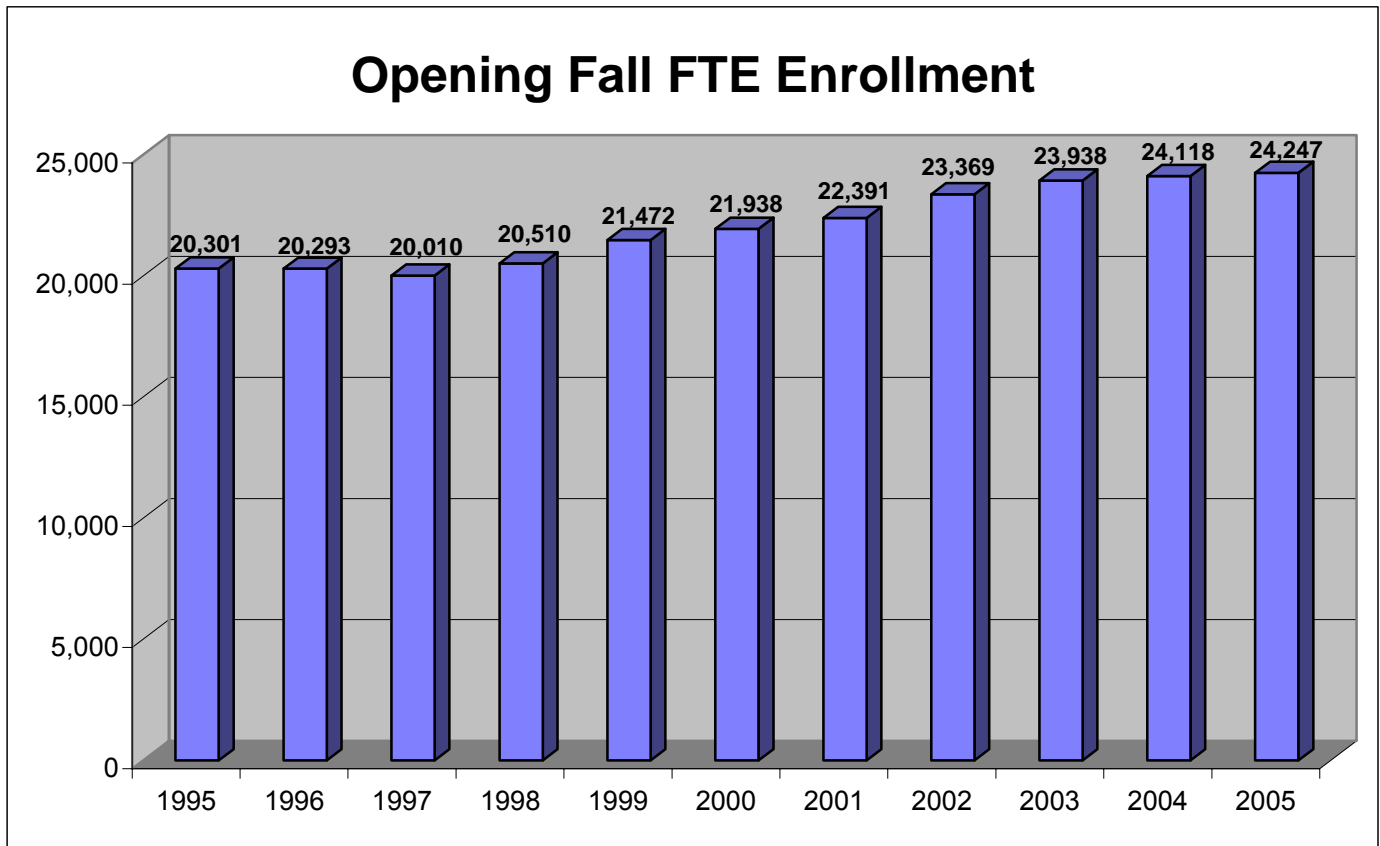

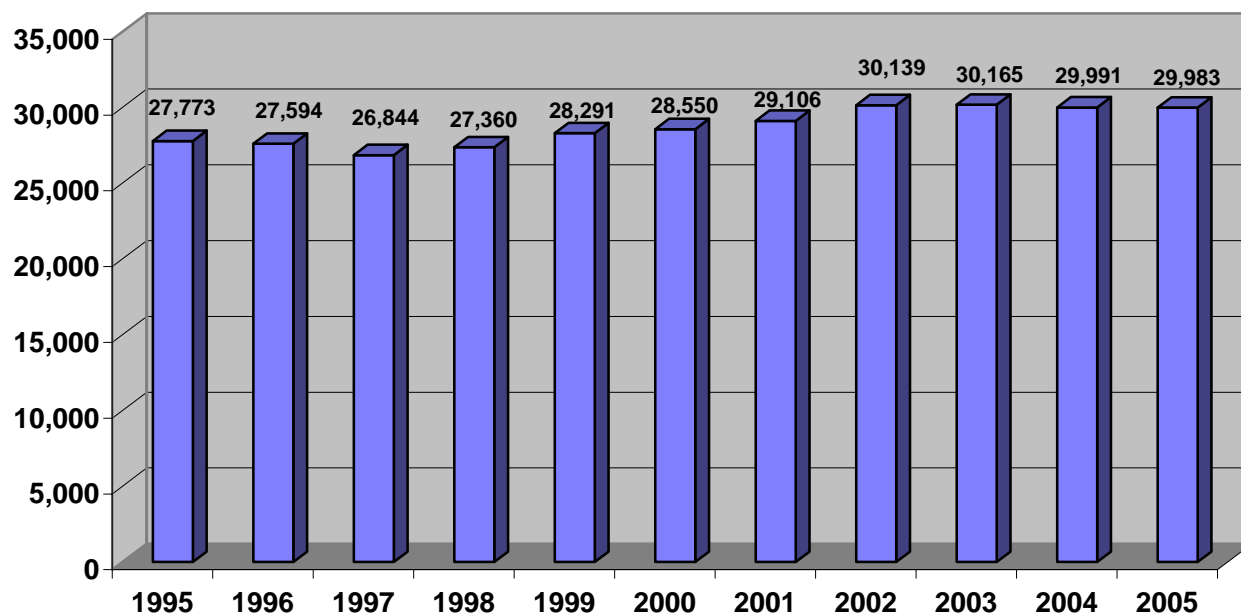

OPENING FALL HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT BY RESIDENCE, BY UNIVERSITY (1995-2005)

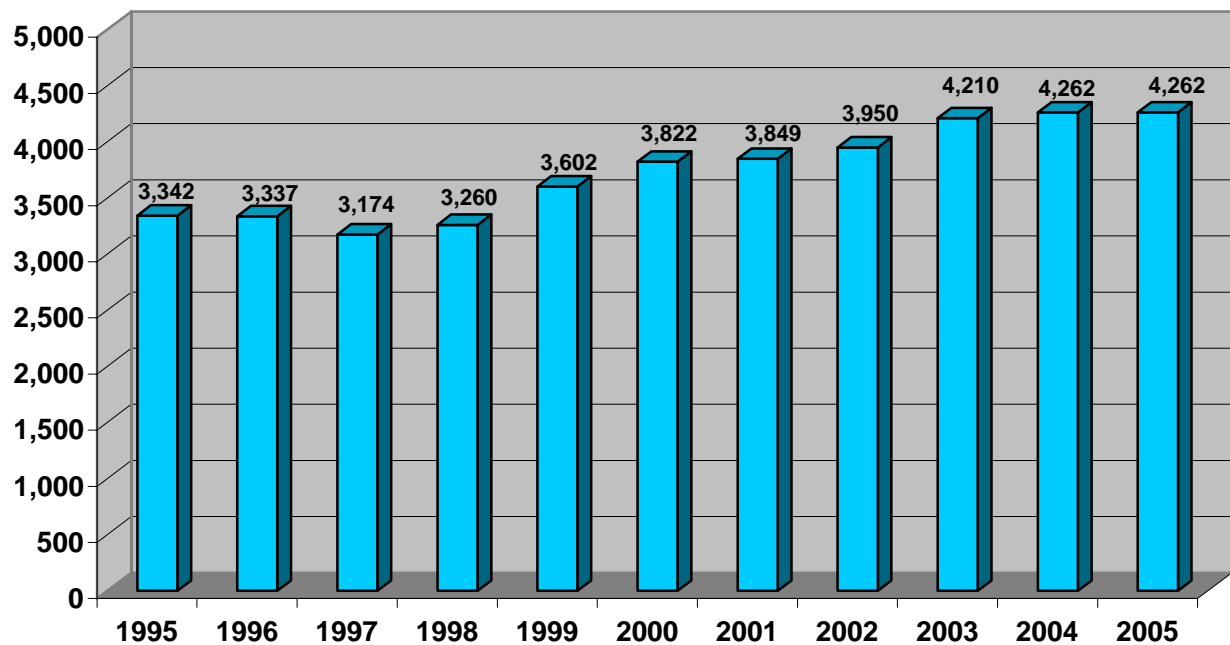

Opening Fall Out-of-State Enrollment

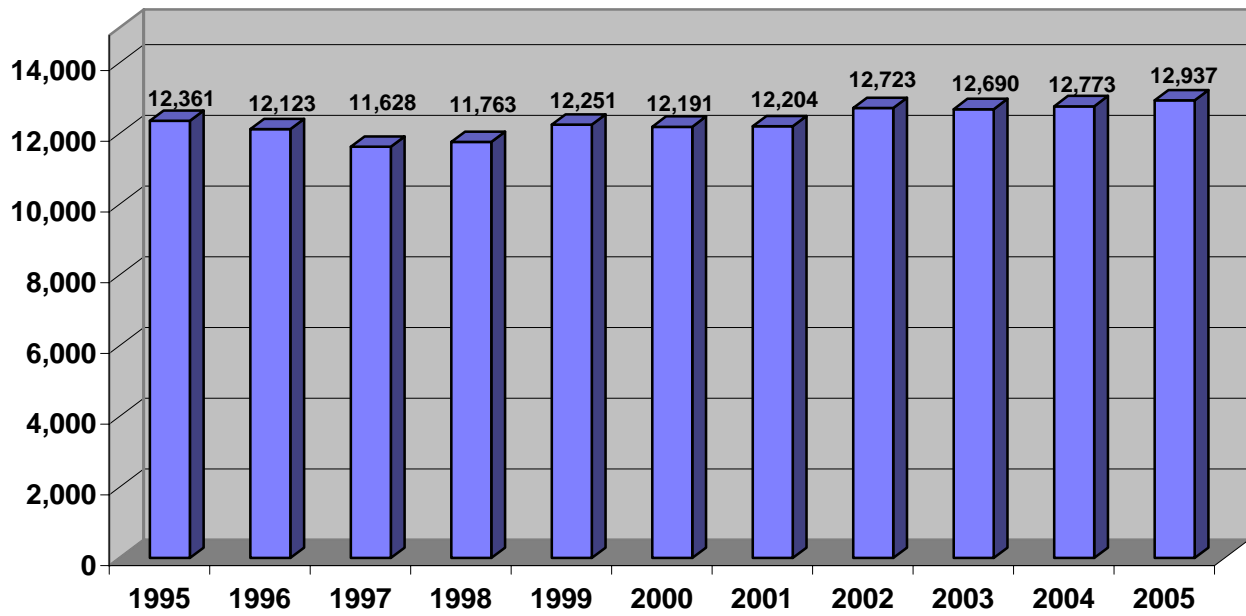

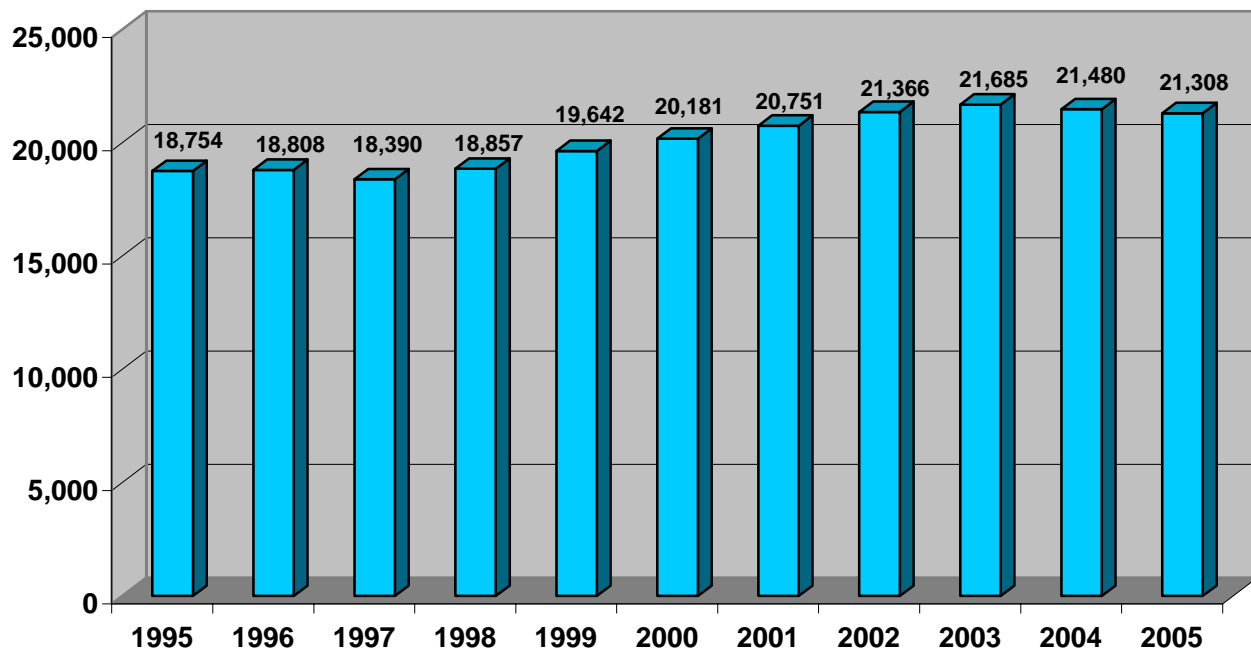

Opening Fall Enrollment - Women

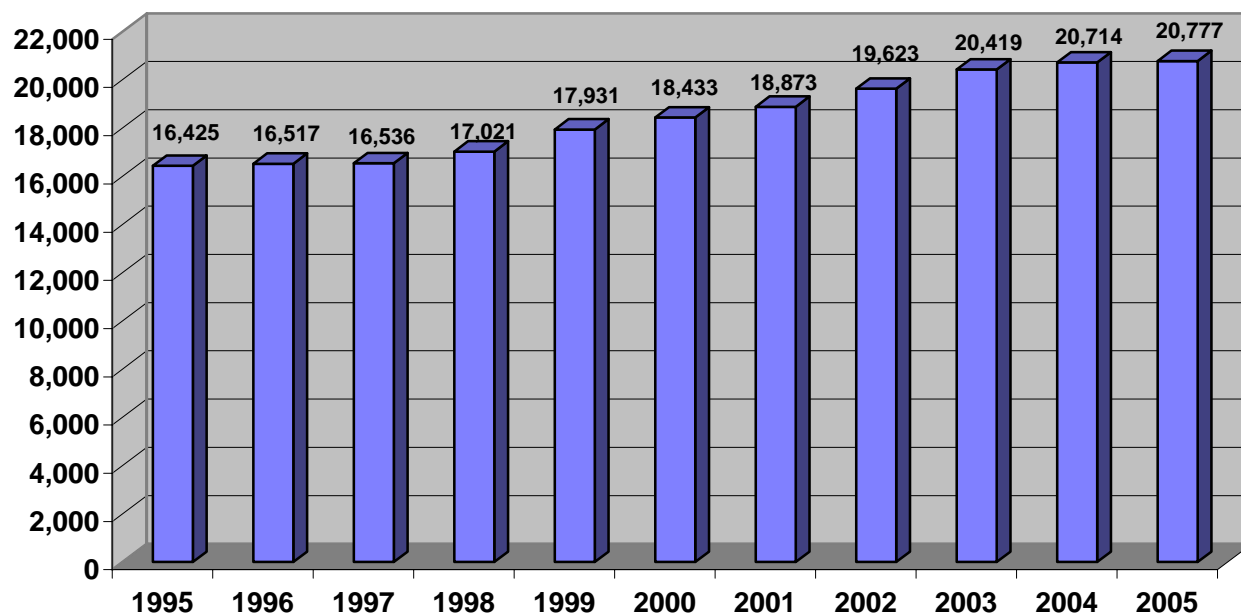


FULL-TIME AND PART-TIME HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT BY UNIVERSITY (1995 - 2005)

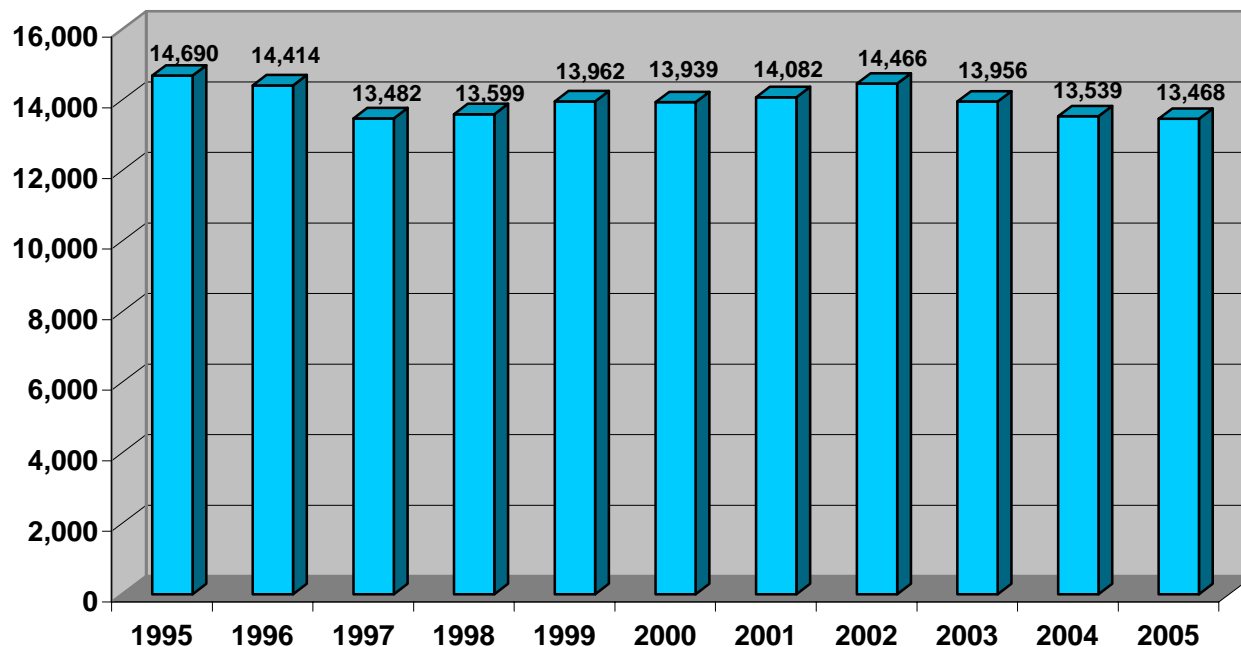

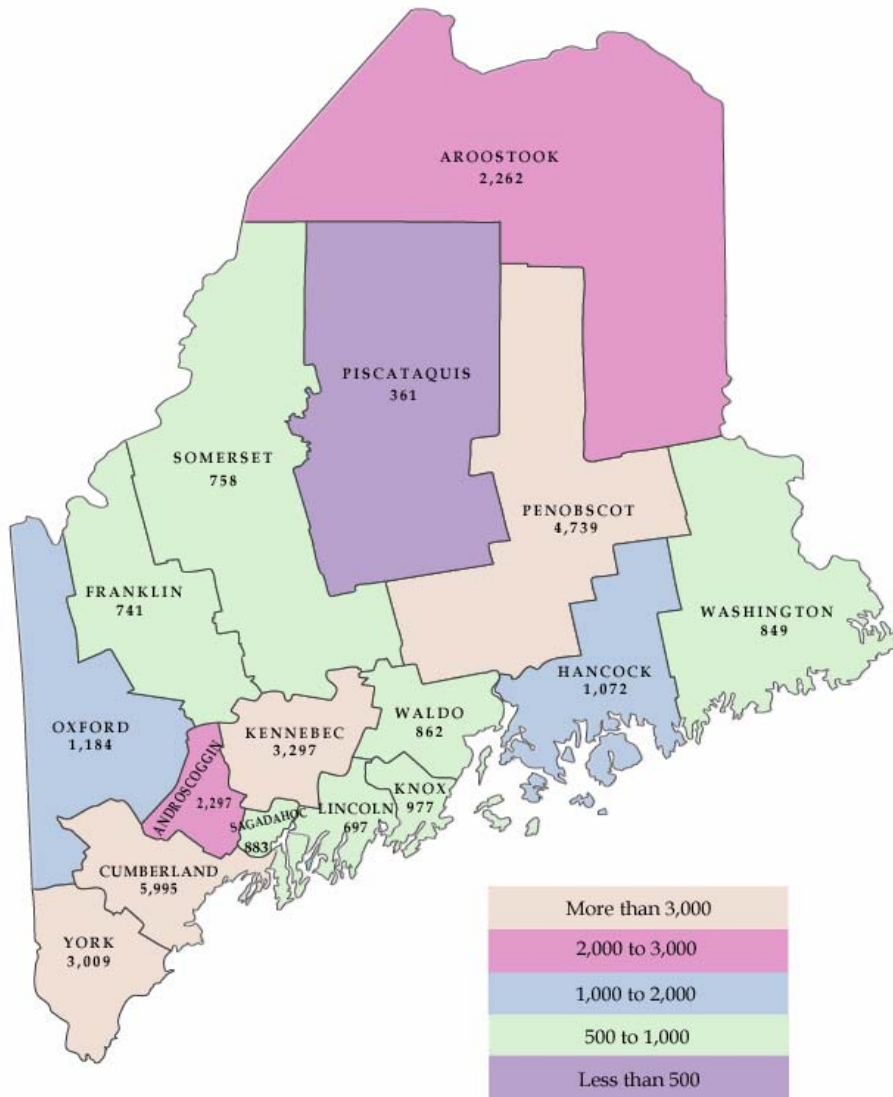
