



SOME LEGAL TIPS FROM THE BETTER BUSINESS BUREAU

1. Read a contract before you sign.
2. Don't be pressured into signing a contract.
3. Check with your legal advisor, if necessary.
4. Check prices of competitive merchandise.
5. Few people give something for nothing.
6. If you are being investigated, get proper identification and clear the investigator's name with the local police or F.B.I. Offer no information until this is done.
7. Be wary of those who promote money making schemes at home by:
 - a. offering huge profits
 - b. offering large part-time earnings
 - c. using incomplete addresses on customer testimonials
 - d. guaranteeing a market
 - e. exaggerating demand
 - f. selling kits, equipment, instruction, and materials at high prices
 - g. claiming no experience is necessary
8. Check salesmen trying to sell "home repair" jobs very carefully. Be sure they are from a reputable firm and that you can get a good reference.
9. Don't ever sign a blank contract.
