<u>Human Resources Wellness Initiatives Update</u>. Ms. Lynda Dec, Chief Human Resources Officer, explained the Wellness Initiative was launched at the University of Maine System on January 1, 2011. Although a large percentage of UMS employees participate in the RiseUp Wellness program to earn a reduction in their health premium, true employee engagement has been a challenge.

Working through the Employee Health Plan Task Force, the Wellness program has made improvements on multiple fronts. These improvements have increased the engagement of UMS employees far beyond the earning of premium credits.

These improvements include:

- Launch of a new Coaching Vendor in 2017
- Wellness Newsletter
- Re-engagement with Campus Wellness Champions
- Wellness Councils
- Campus-generated programs
- Implementation of Benefit Partner Communication Calendar
- Increase in wellness activities (quarterly wellness challenges)
- On-campus seminars and webinars
- New focus on financial wellness

Ms. Dec will plan to come back to the Committee in about six months with more information about the impact of the program.
