5. BACKGROUND:

The current out-of-state tuition rate for USM graduate programs is \$1,141 per credit hour. A 2.5% increase for Fall 2020 would put the rate at \$1170. After a tuition/cost analysis, we propose setting Muskie graduate programs (MPPM and MPH) at the NEHBE rate of \$695 per credit hour. USM projects that current out-of-state enrollment for these programs comprise only 80 credit hours annually. This represents four students out of a total population of 136 in Muskie graduate programs. To offset the tuition gap of \$35,690, USM would need to recruit just three additional students. The University's applicant pool is such that a more regionally competitive price point is likely to yield far more than three additional students.

6. TEXT OF PROPOSED RESOLUTION:

That the Executive Committee on behalf of the Board of Trustees approves the reduction in non-resident tuition rate to \$695 per credit hour, effective Spring 2020.
