#### INTRODUCTION

The following report provides summary information regarding early college enrollment at the University of Maine System for the Fall 2020 semester. All data reported is as of the fall census date (October 15).

#### **Notes:**

- 1. Some totals may not appear to sum correctly due to rounding (e.g., credit hours, FTE, and percentages).
- 2. In the case of inter-institutional cross-listed courses, the Host institution (the UMS institution hosting/teaching the course) receives the credit hours for the course, while the Home institution (the UMS institution where the students' primary enrollment is) keeps the FTE and headcount.
- 3. The formula for calculating Fall FTE (for all campuses except UMF starting in Fall 2006) is as follows: Fall Undergraduate Credit Hours/15 + Fall Professional (Law) Credit Hours/15 + Fall Graduate Credit Hours/9 = Fall FTE + UMF: Fall Undergraduate Credit Hours/16 + Fall Graduate Credit Hours/9 = Fall FTE.
- 4. Students enrolled under the New England Regional Student Program (NEBHE) pay 150% of in-state tuition, which may include out-of-state students and Canadian students.

#### HIGHLIGHTS

- As of October 15, 2020, Concurrent/Dual Enrollment (a UMS institution's curriculum delivered in the high schools by high school faculty) enrolled 1,700 Maine high school students, and Aspirations (high school students enrolled directly in a course at a UMS institution delivered by UMS institution faculty) enrolled 1,736. Another 132 students enrolled in Bridge Year (UMS curriculum delivered in high schools by high school faculty, primarily to students who intend to pursue career/technical training after high school).
- Overall, UMS Early College programs enrolled 3,127 Maine high school students in 15,111 credit hours as
  of October 15, 2020. UMS Early College enrollment accounted for 5.4% of all UMS undergraduate credit
  hours, ranging from 1.2% at UM and UMF to 21.4% at UMFK.
- Despite fewer Maine high school students enrolled in UMS early college in Fall 2020 compared to one year ago (a 5.8% decrease), early college students continue to comprise nearly 14% of UMS undergraduates (13.6% in Fall 2020 vs. 13.8% in 2019).




