

Students who are expected to graduate with the Class of 2026 may earn up to 12 credits per academic year tuition-free

"Available Seats" shown below are \*estimates\* only. Students are not guaranteed a seat in any course until an Early College Administrator reviews their application and changes the status to "Registered."

Starting with the Class of 2027, publicly funded students may earn a lifetime total of 18 tuition-free credits. The annual maximum on tuition-free enrollment remains at 12 credits. Courses taken during the 2025 summer term are counted toward the 2025/2026 academic year credit-limit, regardless of start date.

The deadline for completed applications is 1 week before the class start date regardless of whether there are spots available in the class. (Bridge Academy students may enroll in up to 13 credits in the Fall semester to accommodate their cohort learning model and a year-long course delivery.)

#### Application Status Definitions:

Approved, Pending Registration → Application sent to college/university. Not yet registered for the course. Prerequisite documentation, Parent/Guardian Consent signature, and/or Student Agreement signature may be missing. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

Late Application → Course application was submitted and/or complete after the deadline and will not be processed by college/university.

Section Is Full → Please apply for a new course or contact the host campus for more information.

Waitlist → EC Admin has added student to the course waitlist. Not yet registered for the course
