UNIVERSITY OF MAINE SYSTEM HIPAA POLICY #39 REFRAINING FROM INTIMIDATING OR RETALIATORY ACTS

A Covered Component may not intimidate, threaten, coerce, discriminate against, or take other retaliatory action against:

- A. Any individual for the exercise by the individual of any right under, or for participation by the individual in any process established under HIPAA, including the filing of a complaint.
- B. Any individual or other person:
 - i. Filing a complaint with the Secretary of DHHS;
 - ii. Testifying, assisting, or participating in an investigation, compliance review, proceeding or hearing; or
 - Opposing any act or practice made unlawful by HIPAA, provided the individual or person has a good faith belief that the practice opposed is unlawful, and the manner of the opposition is reasonable and does not involve disclosure of PHI in violation of the Privacy Rule.
