## **QUESTIONS with RESPONSE:**

- Question 01: Addenda #1 revised details on sheet C-501 show a minimum cover of 30" for #4/0 ground conductor in one dimension and 6" min/24" max. on another dimension?
- Response 01: The critical dimensions in the ductbank are that the warning tape shall be installed 12" above the concrete encasement and shall be located a minimum of 6" and maximum of 24" below grade. The #4/0 conductor shall be located between the warning tape and the top of the concrete encasement.
- Question 02: Addenda #1 revised details on sheet C-501 show #4/0 ground conductor a minimum of 12" over conc/flow fill and 30" min below FG, therefore 42" from FG to top of conc/flow fill plus 5" min to top of conduit = 47". Dimension to left calls for 24" of cover. Please clarify.
- Response 02: The critical dimensions in the ductbank are that the warning tape shall be installed 12" above the concrete encasement and shall be located a minimum of 6" and maximum of 24" below grade. The #4/0 conductor shall be located between the warning tape and the top of the concrete encasement.
