## Transition to Aon Health Exchange for January 1, 2021

As part of ongoing efforts to continually review health care benefits and provide retirees with access to quality coverage, the University of Maine System has identified a program that offers flexibility, a variety of plan options, and personalized support to best meet retiree health care needs.

As a result, UMS retirees are transitioning from group health coverage to individual Medicare coverage through Aon Retiree Health Exchange,™ effective January 1, 2021. To help reimburse premiums and qualified expenses, retirees and enrolled dependents will receive funding through a UMS-funded Health Reimbursement Account (HRA).
