SECTION THREE: PRINTING

Trim size: CHANGE FROM 8 3/8" X 10" TO 8 3/8" X 10 7/16"

Responding to vendor inquiries the University has issued this addendum to RFB #11-10:

Question: Do you want any coating on the cover, i.e. aqueous or UV for protection?

Answer: Aqueous.

Question: Do you want the magazine to enter the mail stream from the vendor's plant or do you want the mail ready copies delivered to the mail house for them to enter them into the mail stream?


Answer: The bid form has pricing for the magazine and the mailing. Where the magazine enters the mail stream depends on what the bidder is capable of and how the bidder chooses to respond. The University expects some of the print houses to have an in-house mail capability and some to outsource the mailing.

Question: Stock inside: the specification specifies an option for 55# FLO. I don't have an option for 55# however I do have an option for 50#. Will the 50# be acceptable?

Answer: The specification specifies an option for 55# FLO identified, comparable to FLO recycled coated sheet.

Question: Does the University have a schedule of production?

Answer: We expect to move camera-ready files by mid-January. The spring issue of the magazine must be mailed no earlier than February 19, 2010 and no later than March 1, 2010.
