Q1. Reference paragraph 1.3; Small generator sites.

A1. The number of small generator sites shown in the RFP was incorrect. There are nine (9) small generator sites not six (6).

Q2. Reference paragraph 1.5: deadline for inquires and University responses.

Q3. Reference paragraphs 4.6 and 4.7 on costing. Is there a preferred format for providing the requested information?

A3. No, answer as best you can.

Q4. Reference paragraph 4.7.2; is comingling acceptable?

A4. Yes.

Q5. Reference paragraph 4.7.2; why cost per pound?

A5. The University needs a common basis for price comparison. Price per container is converted to cost per unit of 1#.

Q6. How do you account for State imposed fees?

A6. Bidders can itemize or include the fees in the price per pound.

Q7. Can exceptions be noted to University terms?

A7. Yes. Please clearly identify any exceptions. All proposals will be evaluated with or without exceptions.

Q8. Environmental Impairment Insurance.

A8. The University's Risk Management has requested Environmental Impairment Liability coverage with the University named as additional insured in cases where standard Comprehensive General Liability policies limit environmental or pollution coverage. (Limits are the norm on standard CGL policies). Any deviation must be clearly shown in your proposal especially if you have a unique approach to risk management through insurance coverage.

Q9. Is consolidation of waste possible?

A9. Yes.

Q10. Does transporter provide containers and packing material?

A10. Yes.

Q11. Reference paragraph 4.7.1; does the University provide packing for Universal waste?

A11. It will be both ways, supply boxes and pick up supplied and non-supplied boxes. The University uses a mix of reused containers and HW contractor supplied containers.

Q12. Reference paragraph 4.7.5 Gas cylinders; how is that priced?

A12. Do the best you can. The University has cleaned up most of the problem cylinders over the years. Not many are collected and those are typically lecture size.

Q13. Low level radioactive waste.

A13. Not a large commodity, do the best you can
