This addendum responds to initial questions submitted by vendors.

- Q1. Can the University provide the list of vendors that participated in the mandatory pre-bid inspections?
- A1. Yes, the vendors that participated in Thursday's inspection were Autotronics, Darling's Commercial Sales, and Sugarloaf Vehicles. The vendor that participated in Friday's inspection was First Priority.
- Q2. Does the University want the floor of the ambulance box replaced?
- A2. No, this should not be included in the bid response.
- Q3. Will the new chassis need to be painted to match the ambulance box?
- A3. Yes, the chassis shall be white with the blue stripe to match the ambulance box.
- Q4. Will the decals from the old chassis need to be transferred to the new chassis?
- A4. Yes, either transferred or matched onto the new chassis.
- Q5. The RFB lists the top latches of the rear doors of the ambulance box to be replaced, is that correct or should it be the bottom latches?
- A5. The top latches are in excellent condition, the bottom latches are to be replaced, not the top.
- Q6. The RFB list transfer of existing four (4) lights however the current chassis only has two (2) lights.
- A6. Transfer of existing two (2) lights shall be required.
- Q7. Will the road safety system in the current chassis need to be reinstalled into the new chassis?

- A7. Yes, the bid shall include the transfer of the road safety system.
- Q8. The current chassis is diesel, the RFB calls for gasoline. Will the University want to change the fuel cap to indicate gasoline?
- A8. Yes.
- Q9. Will the cell antenna on the current chassis need to be transferred to the new chassis?
- A9. No, the University currently is not using the cell antenna.
- Q10. The squad bench cover in the ambulance box is damaged, does the University want that to be fixed and included in the bid?
- A10. No, the University will determine if that will be fixed by the awarded vendor after the bid has been awarded.
- Q11. There is minor corrosion damage to the bottom of the ambulance box, does the University want this to be included in the bid to be fixed?
- A11. Yes, the bidders shall include in their bids the cost to fix and paint the ambulance box from the belt line down.
- Q12. Does the University want to be included in the bid the replacement of the rear bumper covers?
- A12. Yes, both of the rear bumper covers are to be replaced and included in the bid.
- Q13. Shall minor damages, issues, etc. that was found during the inspection but not listed be included in the bid?
- A13. No, the University will work with the awarded vendor to address issues, damages, etc. found during the switching of the ambulance box from the old chassis to the new chassis.
- Q14. Does the current unit have a low voltage alarm with monitor lights?
- A14. Yes and this will need to be included in the new chassis.
- Q15. Does the current unit already have the Unlock button in the grille?
- A.15 Yes and this will need to be included in the new chassis.
- Q16. Can the University provide more information on what kind of rear water pump is in the unit?
- A16. The University does not have that information at this time.

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
