**QUESTIONS**

1. Section 1.2.2 of the RFP:

“For FCC regulatory reasons and to ensure ongoing broadcast service continuity, a broadcast license sale typically includes the operating equipment and related site lease assets. In Appendix C, Section 4 of the Translator License Assignment Agreement states that “Buyer will assume all obligations arising from the business and operations of the Translator after the Closing Date.”

Should this read “business and operations of the Translator License after the Closing Date”? If not, and there are other obligations relating to the Translator (such as obligations relating to the Translator’s equipment and site lease), please describe those obligations that the Buyer should expect to assume.

**ANSWER:** The phrase should in fact read “operations pursuant to the Translator License after the Closing Date”. There will be no obligations relating to the Translator’s equipment and site lease.
