**QUESTIONS**

1. Is there specific conduit, or access point that the contract should use to access the building?

**ANSWER:** Yes. Contact the owner of the facility (Maine Fiber Company) for details.

2. Does UMaine have a specific colocation space within the hut and is there space provided to terminate fiber/equipment (rack/wall/etc.) with all required power and backup protection furnished?

**ANSWER:** No. It is the contractor's responsibility to acquire whatever rack space, power, and backup protection for their equipment from the facility owner.

3. Will the contractor have access to this space to maintain the services so that the service requirements of the bid can be met?

**ANSWER:** Contact the facility owner for details and requirements.

4. Will there be any Monthly recurring and/or non-recurring charges to Spectrum Enterprise by the MFC for required rack space, power or cross connections in this MFC facility?

**ANSWER:** We cannot speak on behalf of the facility owner. Contact the facility owner for details and requirements.

5. Could the University provide additional details regarding the "Dual 10Gbps Service" option?

**ANSWER:** We are asking for pricing on two (2) 10Gbps ports.

6. Is August 15<sup>th</sup> is a hard required installation date?

**ANSWER:** From page 55 of RFP: "Bidders must describe their ability to have the proposed services installed and ready for use by the University before August 15, 2017." While August 15<sup>th</sup> is not a hard set date if a bidder cannot meet this target date they should provide an explanation of what prevents them from meeting the August 15 target along with a service availability date that they are confident they can meet. Significant deviation from the August 15<sup>th</sup> target date will impact the evaluation of the bidder's proposal.

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7. We need specific addresses for all locations that are part of the bid, including room number or suite where services would be delivered on each campus.

**ANSWER:** We are asking for services to be delivered to 9 Westland Ave. Portland, Maine as stated in Appendix K of the RFP on page 56. We are not asking contractors to deliver services directly to any University campus.
