QUESTIONS

1. On page 8 of the RFP, it states that the equipment owned by the University is provided in Appendix B- Cost Response Form. I've looked at Appendix B(22) - which is Debarment, Performance and Non-Collusion certification - It's not there. I did find the Cost Response Form(24), however, there is no list of equipment owned by the university that we would need to service if we were awarded the contract. Is there a list that we could have? In driving around the campus' we noticed a handful of outside bait stations, and there are likely fly lights in food service areas. Will the fly lights & bait stations be removed by the current company?

ANSWER: Any equipment owned by the University can be used but are not required. Any equipment you bring on site should be specified in the Cost Response Form as required by your service proposal.

2. Scope of Service -
Residential buildings - Is the contractor expected to inspect every dorm room at each monthly visit? Or are there work orders that are created for rooms that need treatment?

ANSWER: No. You would inspect all other areas interiorly and exteriorly. Inspection and treatment in dorm rooms are as needed and considered high priority for response time.

3. Do all of the buildings have basements? Specifically, residential buildings, if you had information on E&G buildings that would be beneficial also.

ANSWER: All of the residential buildings have basements. Some E&G buildings have basements. Some are used as mechanical or storage, others are occupied space. Wishcamper, Abromson and Glickman all have non occupied basements for example.
